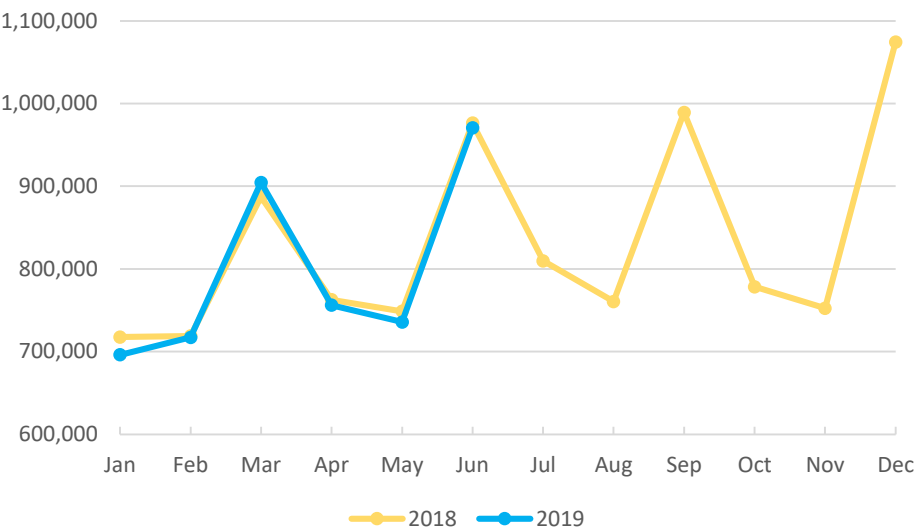

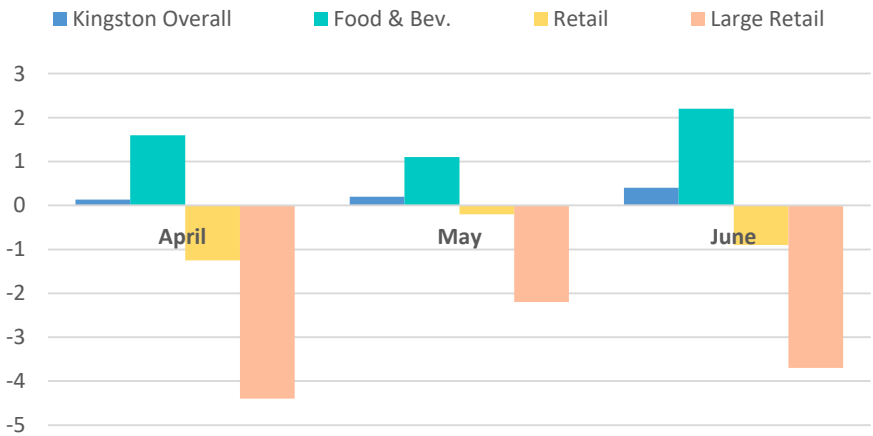

SALES % CHANGE YEAR ON YEAR



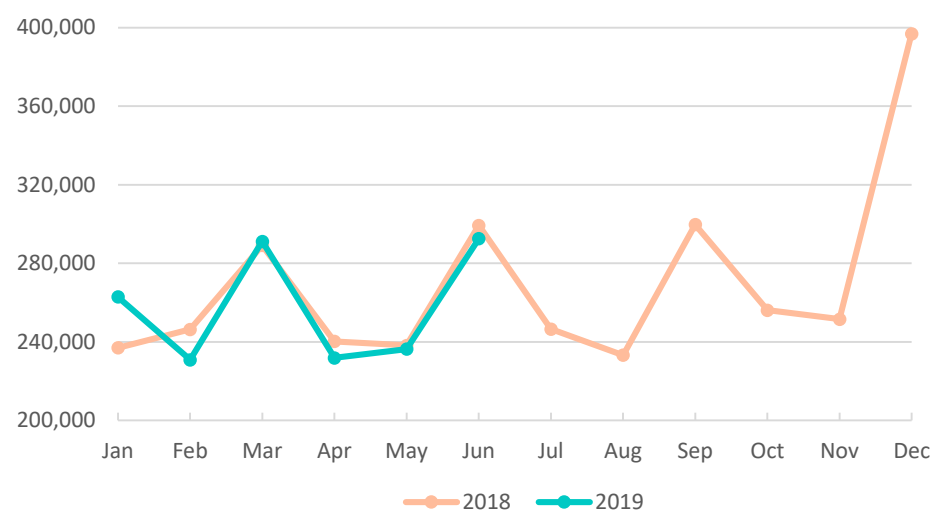

Graph reflects % change sales data from selected retailers in Kingston town centre. Weekly data figures are averaged across the month.

- In June, the BRC reported like for like UK retail sales decreased by -1.6% YoY.
- The report notes in June 2018 the country was enjoying the World Cup and very warm weather, which led to strong sales, and impulse purchases, of goods such as garden furniture, TV's and BBQs.
- The BRC note it's much tougher for retailers this year, with increases in real wages failing to translate into greater consumer spending and general political and economic uncertainty damaging consumer confidence. The only sector which the BRC notes had a good month is the furniture category, as people choose to spend time at home watching sporting events.
- Overall, Kingston faired better in June with overall sales slightly up by 0.4%, largely due to a strong performance by the food and beverage sector. In line with the BRC report, retail of every size had a tough month.
